

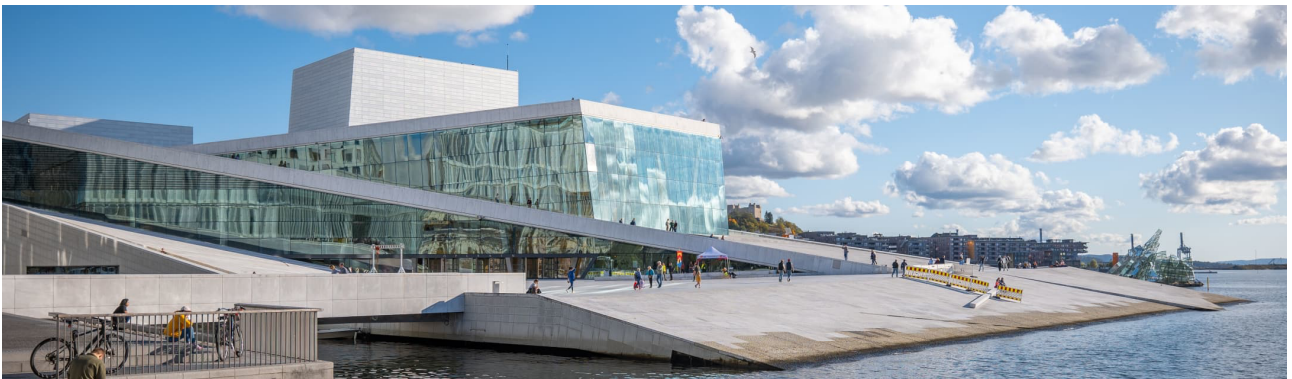
Summer 2025
